.22LR Practical Precision Rifle Match at the Rifle Range

The club will be hosting a .22LR Practical Precision Rifle Match Saturday September 9th, the arrive time is 9:00 am sharp - the shoot will take place rain or shine.

Whether you're an advanced shooter or just want to have some fun shooting .22's, this is the place to do it. Fun for all ages. Meet friends and improve your shooting skills. Challenge yourself with your marksman skills, pressure drills, shooting tiny toothpicks in half, positional shooting, hitting targets at alternating distances and more.

NOTE: The rifle range will be closed on the day of the match, no other shooting will be allowed. Members who have not signed up for the shoot are welcome to come and observe the match.

Registration details:

- ❖ Last day to sign-up and prepay is September 1st.
- ❖ Entry fee **MUST** be prepaid, your name doesn't go on the roster until payment is received.
- ❖ \$30.00 per adult shooter.
- ❖ \$20.00 for shooters 16 and under. **SHOOTERS UNDER THE AGE OF 16 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A GUARDIAN DURING THE MATCH WITH A VALID PAL.**
- ❖ To register and prepay, you must contact Roy at the e-mail or phone indicated below. You will need to provide the following information: your name and e-mail address, phone number, as well as ammo and firearms/optics details such as make and model and list any modifications done.
- ❖ Cancellation must be made up to one week before the match otherwise you will forfeit the registration fee. You are welcome to transfer your spot to someone else but **YOU** are responsible for collecting the amount you agreed upon for the spot.
- ❖ .22LR only, no other rimfire.
- ❖ All shooters must know the club range rules. Shooters under the age of 16 must have a legal Guardian present at the match.
- ❖ You are required arrive **AT LEAST 30 minutes** early to attend the safety meeting to be held before the start of the match. **IMPORTANT:** If you miss the safety meeting you will not be allowed to shoot.

- ❖ Once the signups are complete and the targets are posted no additional person allowed to join the match.

Gear details:

- ❖ A spotting scope is optional but helps a lot.
- ❖ Appropriate eye and ear protection are mandatory.
- ❖ An accurate rifle and good optics - preferably the type that can focus down to 25 yards. We will be shooting at tiny targets the size of matchsticks.
- ❖ NO TUBE FED RIFLES (they take too long to load and unload).
- ❖ A good bipod can be helpful. (My Favorite is Harris 6-9" BRM-S).
- ❖ A rear bag helps.
- ❖ A mat to lay on, we will be shooting from several positions.
- ❖ Accurate .22LR ammo.
- ❖ A chamber flag is mandatory. You can easily make one from a zip tie with red ribbon or you can buy one for \$0.50 the day of the match.
- ❖ At least one ten round magazine, two is better, or one ten round and one five round.
- ❖ A sling can help in some of the stages.
